Drop-in sessions to help older residents

Friendly faces are out and about in the Corangamite community, helping older residents access the services they need.

Corangamite Shire Council's Positive Ageing & Inclusion team are visiting libraries across the Shire.

"So far we have been to Camperdown, Cobden, Derrinallum and Skipton," Service Navigation Support Officer Lesa Best said.

Two more visits are planned for each of those towns, in August and September.

"We are having a great time meeting our wonderful senior residents and sharing information on the assistance that is available to them," Ms Best said.

"A whole range of aged care and assessment services are provided by a range of different organisations across the Shire.

"At times that might be confusing or intimidating but we're here to help our residents get the support they need."

Ms Best said the team could help residents

- understand the aged care system including eligibility, access, assessment and how to find a service provider;
- link in with other agencies including social services, health and community participation opportunities;
- join in with active aging programs and activities to keep them healthy, active and connected; and
- access food relief.

"We can also link carers to support services and networks, and advocate for the community," Ms Best said.

"Getting to know our residents face to face means we know their needs and can advocate for our community.

"The Navigation Support Program is free and confidential. Come along to one of the sessions below to learn how the Navigation Support Program can help you."



Moreton Hill Wind Farm

The proposed Moreton Hill Wind Farm is located on Wadawurrung Country, about 35 kilometres southwest of Ballarat. The wind farm will have up to 62 turbines, producing enough electricity to power around 260,000 homes and prevent almost 350,000 tonnes of emissions annually.

The wind farm is proposed to connect to the electricity network via a new underground 220kV powerline to the Berrybank terminal station about nine kilometres south of the wind farm.

TO BUILD PYRAMID.

If American builders were called upon to-day to erect a counterpart of the Great Pyramid of Cheops, how long would it take? How much would Would they recommend the same structural design? When these questions were suggested the other day to New York architects and builders, they proved so interesting that three of them volunteered to make the necessary calculations. To reproduce the Great Pyramid in stone blocks like those of the original would be an engineering project requiring five and a half years. The cost would be 156,000,-000 dollars (normally £21,200,000). The labor needed would amount to 2,250,000 man-days, each of these units representing the work of one laborer during a working day. According to this estimate, the use of modern machinery would cut by nearly 99 per cent, the labor required in ancient times, since historical accounts indicate that the Great Pyramid took 180,000,000 man-days to build. ever, modern architects could produce a durable pyramid at a much greater saving in labor and cost by substituting a skeleton of reinforced concrete, faced with limestone. Such a pyramid would cost 15,000,000 dollars (£3,000, 000), and would require 750,000 mandays to erect.

Electoral Commissioner, Sven Bluemmel, has issued a call to state- and council-enrolled voters to be ready to cast their vote in the upcoming local council election for Corangamite Shire Council.

The Corangamite Shire Council election will be conducted by post – a safe and completely secret method of voting.

Electoral Commissioner Sven Bluemmel issued a call to Corangamite Shire residents and ratepayers to be ready to have their say.

'Make sure you're enrolled correctly by the close of roll, which is **4 pm on Wednesday 7 August**. As this is a postal election, it's important to check your address details are correct – this includes any alternative postal address,' Mr Bluemmel said.

'If you're an Australian citizen and recently turned 18, or moved and haven't updated your address, or if you've just closed your post office box with Australia Post, you can enrol or update your details online at vec.vic.gov.au/enrolment'

People living outside Corangamite Shire who pay rates for a property they own in Corangamite Shire, non-Australian citizens who occupy and pay rates on a property in Corangamite Shire, or a representative of a company or business operating in Corangamite Shire can apply to the council to enrol by calling 5593 7100.

Mr Bluemmel also reminded voters that the rules for council enrolments have recently changed.

'Voting in local council elections is now compulsory for all state- and council-enrolled voters. In previous elections it was not compulsory for council-enrolled voters to vote – now everyone must vote if they are on the voters' roll.'

Voters who will be away during the election period can have their ballot pack redirected to an address of their choice by completing a redirection form online at vec.vic.gov.au by Monday 9 September.

More information is available by calling 131 832 or at vec.vic.gov.au, where state-enrolled voters can also sign up to the free VoterAlert service to receive important election reminders by SMS and email.






