Vietnam Veterans Day, Skipton, 2024.

It was a privilege for the Friends of the RSL Skipton Branch to be able to hold a ceremony in Skipton on Sunday 18th August to honour Australians who served in all branches of the Services, those who were wounded and survived, and those who were damaged by their experiences. And especially we think of those who died in the service of their country In the Vietnam Conflict.

A deeply committed gathering was welcomed at the Skipton
War Memorial by Friends' President Graham Layley, who recalled the
history of the Vietnam War and the part played by Australian Servicemen.
The date, August 18th is that of the Battle of Long Tan, fought in 1966, in the rubber
plantations east of Nui Dat. By a bizarre coincidence that afternoon troops were
being entertained in Nui Dat by singers Little Patti and Col Joye, troops on patrol
could hear occasional snatches of sound through the trees! A talking point on
Sunday was our "sound track" to the informal BBQ lunch that
followed the brief service and the laying of significant wreaths, the music of the
sixties has survived so well.

It was a privilege to have with us on Sunday Malcolm Fletcher and Bob Baysinger, both veterans who identify with Skipton. Wreaths were laid to commemorate the lives of veterans Paul Heenan and Des Zanker, Skipton men who returned from Vietnam, and who have recently passed. As part of his address Graham Layley read a list of those veterans who we will continue to honour (due to this late entry to the Skipton Community News this will be published next week), we would very much appreciate contact with anyone we have missed, or who have made Skipton their home recently.

Thank you Skipton for helping so willingly, especially our sponsors the Country
Grocers who provided the food, and the numerous helpers who
made this special day the meaningful occasion it was, a day of acknowledgement,
memories and thanks to a generation of young Australians who served
their country.

Drop-in sessions to help older residents

Friendly faces are out and about in the Corangamite community, helping older residents access the services they need.

Corangamite Shire Council's Positive Ageing & Inclusion team are visiting libraries across the Shire.

"So far we have been to Camperdown, Cobden, Derrinallum and Skipton," Service Navigation Support Officer Lesa Best said.

Two more visits are planned for each of those towns, in August and September.

"We are having a great time meeting our wonderful senior residents and sharing information on the assistance that is available to them," Ms Best said.

"A whole range of aged care and assessment services are provided by a range of different organisations across the Shire.

"At times that might be confusing or intimidating but we're here to help our residents get the support they need."

Ms Best said the team could help residents

- understand the aged care system including eligibility, access, assessment and how to find a service provider;
- link in with other agencies including social services, health and community participation opportunities;
- join in with active aging programs and activities to keep them healthy, active and connected; and
- access food relief.

"We can also link carers to support services and networks, and advocate for the community," Ms Best said.

"Getting to know our residents face to face means we know their needs and can advocate for our community.

Moreton Hill Wind Farm

The proposed Moreton Hill Wind Farm is located on Wadawurrung Country, about 35 kilometres southwest of Ballarat. The wind farm will have up to 62 turbines, producing enough electricity to power around 260,000 homes and prevent almost 350,000 tonnes of emissions annually.

The wind farm is proposed to connect to the electricity network via a new underground 220kV powerline to the Berrybank terminal station about nine kilometres south of the wind farm.




