Moreton Hill Wind Farm

The proposed Moreton Hill Wind Farm is located on Wadawurrung Country, about 35 kilometres southwest of Ballarat. The wind farm will have up to 62 turbines, producing enough electricity to power around 260,000 homes and prevent almost 350,000 tonnes of emissions annually.

The wind farm is proposed to connect to the electricity network via a new underground 220kV powerline to the Berrybank terminal station about nine kilometres south of the wind farm.

DUKE'S AERIAL TOURS

KINGSFORD SMITH TO BE PILOT.

SOUTHERN CROSS TO BE USED.

SYDNEY, Wednesday.

At the invitation of the New South Wales Government, Sir Charles Kingsford Smith has agreed to act as pilot for the Duke of Gloucester during his aerial visits to country districts of New South Wales.

The Duke will fly from Sydney to Lismore and back. Owing to the bad condition of the aerodrome at Coff's Harbor, the machine will not land there. The Duke will be flown as far as Lismore, and will travel the next stage to Coff's Harbor by train. He will leave Coff's Harbor by plane and then fly to Newcastle.

It is likely that the old Southern Cross will be used, and Mr Stannage is already preparing special radio equipment to enable the Duke to keep in constant touch with the ground by wireless telephony.

If the big plane is used, the Duke will probably be accompanied by the Chief of Police, a private detective, Mr John Stannage, Lady Kingsford Smith, and a newspaper representative.

THE USEFUL NEWSPAPER.

I think we should be lost in the home without the handy newspaper which we put to such a variety of uses, quite apart from its primary use, that of conveying the news and all the topics of the day.

When you are faced with the dirty job of cleaning the cooking stove, pads of newspaper help to get off the worst of the grease and dirt. Some people use dusters and cloths in the first place, and they suffer accordingly. It is an economy as well as the better method to clean off the surface grease with a newspaper, before approaching it with a cloth and hot water.

You can save lots of firewood by making paper firelighters. To make these, fold the paper in long rolls and then twist and knot it. These are splendid for lighting the fire, and take the place of sticks.

When you have an accumulation of refuse, peeling, etc., wrap them up well in several thicknesses of newspaper before throwing on the kitchen fire. This is by far the best way of disposing of all leavings. If they are inclined to cause a smell, throw some salt on. This will abolish the odor.

Sensible housewives always use newspaper for temporary stands for saucepans, they avoid such a lot of dirt. When dishing up, it is a good idea to spread several layers over the kitchen table.

If you are short of dust-sheets, you can make up with old newspapers if you pin sheets together to the necessary size.

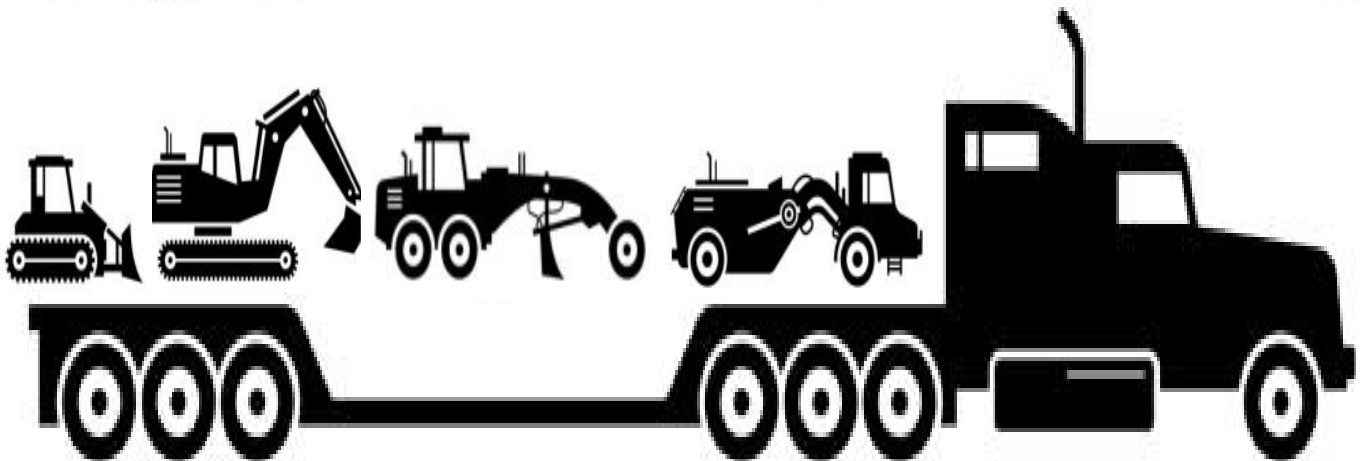

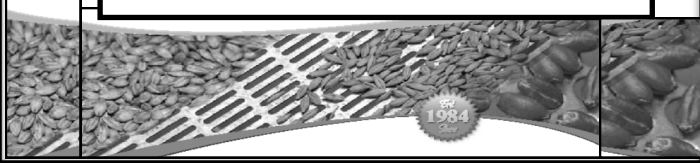
