



#### **Moreton Hill Wind Farm**

The proposed Moreton Hill Wind Farm is located on Wadawurrung Country, about 35 kilometres southwest of Ballarat. The wind farm will have up to 62 turbines, producing enough electricity to power around 260,000 homes and prevent almost 350,000 tonnes of emissions annually.

The wind farm is proposed to connect to the electricity network via a new underground 220kV powerline to the Berrybank terminal station about nine kilometres south of the wind farm.

#### BECAUSE IT DIDN'T RAIN.

Centuries ago a king of Sweden was stabbed by his eldest son because the crops had been ruined. A similar mistake by the king of the neighboring country of Norway led to a revolt of the nobles and the burning alive of the besieged ruler in his palace. The idea has even persisted to the present day. When he was Emperor of China in 1912 one of the duties of Pu Yi was to see that an adequate supply of water descended on his domains.

This superstition has given trouble to royal families all over the world. The coronation oath of one of the South Sea Islands contained a promise that only the best weather would be provided, and the punishment for breaking it was death. Naturally a prolonged drought brought rapid changes, not only of the monarch but of the dynasty itself. Finally no family could be induced to take on the kingship, and it became extinct.

One Chinese custom was to construct a huge dragon, of wood and paper, representing the rain-giving spirit. It was drawn through the streets in procession and feted by the populace. In return it was expected to send the rain, but if it still refused it was set upon by the mob and torn limb from limb.

Perhaps the best method, however, was that of a tribe in West Africa. Their practice was to light a huge bon-fire and heap upon it all the most inflammable material they possessed. As the long flame leapt into the sky the natives danced, yelling to their gods that unless rain was forthcoming, and quickly, they would make an even bigger conflagration, which would set the heavens themselves on fire.






