





# **Moreton Hill Wind Farm**

The proposed Moreton Hill Wind Farm is located on Wadawurrung Country, about 35 kilometres southwest of Ballarat. The wind farm will have up to 62 turbines, producing enough electricity to power around 260,000 homes and prevent almost 350,000 tonnes of emissions annually.

The wind farm is proposed to connect to the electricity network via a new underground 220kV powerline to the Berrybank terminal station about nine kilometres south of the wind farm.

# BELOW ARE SOME EXTRACTS FROM 1934 FROM THE SKIPTON STANDARD & STREATHAM GAZETTE FROM 90 YEARS AGO

LOCATED IN THE SHS POLICE HOUSE MUSEUM, MONTGOMERY STREET, SKIPTON.

#### EELS BY THE TON

On his property at Skipton Mr Ernest G. Austin has a spring with a dam across which is a drain running into a lake, that now has 17ft. of water. Both spring and lake must carry a good many eels. This season the shearers and the Porriyalloak men got three tons and sent them The eels were into Ballarat for sale. practically all the one size-3 to 41b in weight-a point that causes Mr Austin to wonder whether at this size they reach breeding age and become available when trying to migrate, whereas the smaller eels remain Eels caught in the Emu Creek are never more than about 11b. in weight, but it is presumed that they belong to the same species.

#### WHEN DO EELS MIGRATE?

Stating that he has always been of the opinion that elvers migrated in the springtime, Mr Au tin reports that his son, Claud saw large numbers trying to climb the cemented bluestone bank of the weir at Carranballac, on Mt Emu Creek, in February. They were also seen going up rocks in the same creek above Borriyallock, several miles from the weir, n the same month, In each instance the migration was taking place in daylight. The eels were failing to get up the wall of the weir, apparently because they could not get wet enough.

Replying to questions by Mr Austin, I am under the impression that the usual migration period of eels is the late spring; that the large eels of Gippsland lakes are the same kind as those found at Skipton, and that lampreys are rather rare in the southern waters. Elvers seen making their way up a drain in a street at Skipton last week would be "on time," and the migrants of February would, pereaps

be a late batch.

#### WATER EVERYWHERE.

Water is essential to life. Man is two-thirds water. If the human body could be dried up completely it would scarcely turn the scales at fifty pounds. Half the food we eat is water. Some fruits, such as melons and marrows, are almost entirely composed of water. The average person's daily food contains two and a half pints of water. To keep thoroughly fit he should drink three more pints. world's best drink is water. All others are merely colored and flavored imitations. If we appreciated the real value of water, we should judge it to be cheap at a penny a pint.

It is necessary as a solvent and a tissue builder. It should be taken in sufficient quantity to wash waste materials from the body—to clear out those poisons which, if retained, cause tired feelings and cloudy brains. Fifty per cent. of people past the age of thirty would really enjoy the heat of summer if they drank nothing but water for twenty-four hours, and followed that with two days of water and oranges only.

Next to water, the best drinks are made from the juice and pulp of lemons and oranges. These drinks must be unsweetened and taken in the early morning. Both contain a big supply of vitamins. The lemon is not an acid but an alkali. When in doubt, drink water.



#### Positive Ageing and Inclusion Team to visit libraries

Older residents across Corangamite Shire have more opportunities to get help accessing the services they need

Council's Positive Ageing and Inclusion Team are again visiting libraries across the Shire.

Chief Executive Officer David Rae said the team could help residents

- understand the aged care system including eligibility, access, assessment and how to find a service provider;
- link in with other agencies including social services, health and community participation opportunities;

#### Free domestic green waste disposal for fire prep

In preparation for the fire season, Corangamite Shire Council will offer free domestic green waste drop offs from Saturday 26 October until Sunday 17 November.

Corangamite Shire Chief Executive Officer David Rae said fire authorities had advised there is potential for an early start to the fire season if warm, dry conditions continue to dry out fuels towards summer.

"In preparation for the fire season, Council will accept domestic green waste for free at Corangamite Regional Landfill and all Council transfer stations from Saturday 26 October until Sunday 17 November inclusive.

"This is to encourage residents to clean up their properties in preparation for the fire season. It is for non-commercial customers only.

"Winter and spring have seen a "green drought" across the Shire where paddocks appeared green on top, but very low soil moisture.

"That bit of green doesn't mean it's OK to sit back. It only takes two weeks of hot, dry weather for green vegetation to become a serious hazard.

"Now is the time to get rid of dry grass, leaves, twigs and bark in your gutters and around your house.

"Normally a heaped trailer or ute load of green waste would cost \$40 to drop off. For the next three weeks it's free.

"One overgrown block can pose a hazard to a whole neighbourhood so cleaning up now can help protect you, your home and your neighbours."

Mr Rae encouraged residents to have a fire plan and to make sure all family members know what to do if there is a fire.

"Now is the best time to understand your fire risk and get prepared, not when a fire starts," he said.

"You can download a guide from cfa.vic.gov.au/firereadykit

Fire inspections will start in the next couple of weeks.






